

## Our Achievement Targets...

By 2020 we will...

### NAPLAN

- 1.1 Increase the percentage of students in Years 3 & 5 achieving in the Top 20% in NAPLAN in all tested areas to equal or above like schools.
- 1.2 Ensure all students are at or above National minimum standard in NAPLAN in all tested areas.
- 1.3 Improve student 'progress and achievement data' to indicate both high progress and high achievement compared to like schools.

### Attendance

- 2.1 Improve overall student attendance rates.
- 2.2 Decrease percentage of students in 'at-risk' attendance categories.

### Teacher Judgement

- 3.1 Ensure teacher judgement is 'within or more than' half to one standard deviation above the expected grade allocation.

### On-Entry

- 4.1 Assure all students make sound progress (1.0 progression points) between Pre-primary to Year 2 assessments.

### Progressive Achievement Tests (PAT)

- 5.1 Maintain or improve the number of students in the Top 20% of Australian Schools in all PAT Tests (Reading, Spelling, Grammar & Punctuation, Maths and Science).

### Student Wellbeing

- 6.1 View an upward trend of mean "SEW Score" [Social and Emotional Wellbeing] in PAT Social –Emotional Wellbeing Survey.
- 6.2 View an improved percentage of students in level 4 – 6 (4. High / 5. Very high / 6. Highest) in the overall summary of PAT Social –Emotional Wellbeing Survey.
- 6.3 Ensure an improved percentage of students in moderate and high areas when results defined by specific areas.
