Edu-Dance

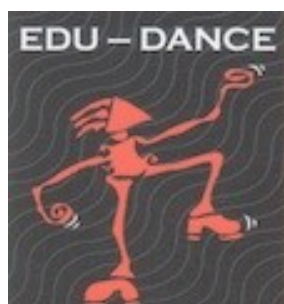

A program of events for the faction athletics carnival to be held next Friday 13 September will be sent out on Skoolbag as soon as it is available



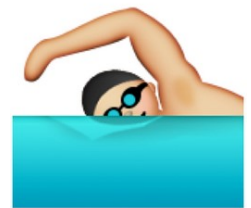
Chess Club
